Our demands for change became even more urgent this month because President Trump is trying to cut \$7 billion of funding from the Children's Health Insurance Program, a move that could snatch health insurance away from 9 million children. He's also doubling down on a push for work requirements for SNAP recipients that could slash tens of billions of dollars from the program and cut benefits to 1 million households.
